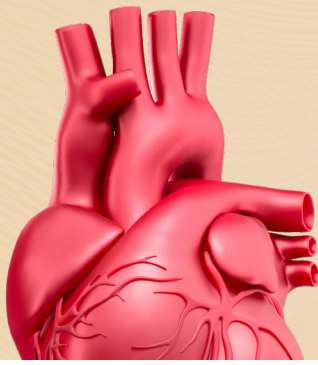
Venue information

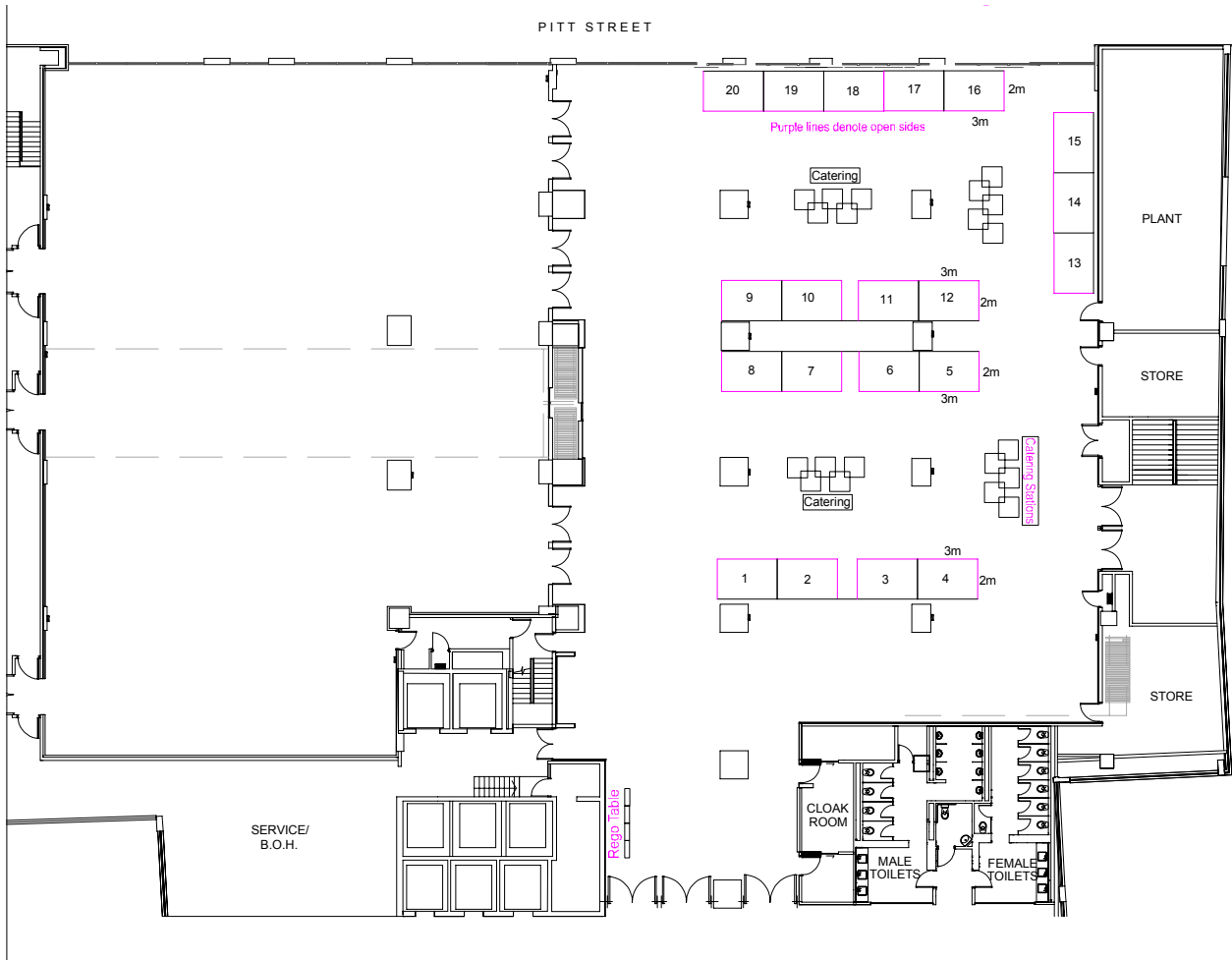

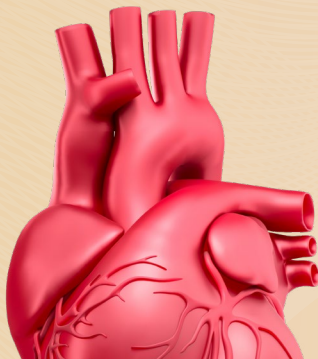
