17. Renton Prize

The Renton Prize was established by the Faculty of Anaesthetists, Royal Australasian College of Surgeons, in 1956.

17.1 The Prize is open to all candidates admitted to the Primary Examinations for Fellowship of the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists.

17.2 The Prize shall take the form of a medal.

17.3 The Prize shall be awarded to the eligible candidate who shall have reached a standard considered by the Examiners to be sufficiently high to justify the award.

17.4 If two or more candidates are found to have reached the required standard and to have been allotted the same number of marks, being the highest obtained by any eligible candidate, it shall be open to the Examiners to take such steps as they may think desirable to enable them adjudicate in the matter. Joint award of the Prize may be considered.
